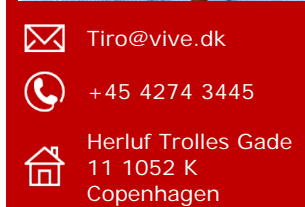




CV Tine Rostgaard
